"First to Slide" Contest announced for new tube slide opening

Fort Smith, Ark – May 13, 2021 – Fort Smith area youngsters will have a chance to be the first people to experience the new tube slide, the O'Hana Highway, at Parrot Island Waterpark later this summer. Videos must be submitted by June 30th and contain the words "Parrot Island Waterpark First to Slide" in the title and the audio, include the hashtag #parrotislandwaterpark, and meet other criteria.
